Send \$1.00 to school with your child on Tuedays for two pikelets with jam and


cream. A yummy treat with funds going towards our Sustainability program. A big thanks to Rhelma for cooking and organising this!



Students will travel by bus in their class groups and take part in some fun and engaging activities.




